Southern Command personnel handled 1222 crashes in November, 2011. Of these, 878 were property damage, 342 were injury, and 2 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 1.8% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities decreased 75.0%. 30 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles 6 resulted in injuries, 24 were property damage, and 0 resulted in fatalities. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 2.45% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 2% of all crashes in the Southern Command.
