Overview

Southern Command personnel handled 1023 crashes in June 2012. Of these, 728 were property damage, 291 were injury, and 0 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 3.6% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities decreased 600.0%. 37 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles, 8 resulted in injuries, 29 were property damage, and 0 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 3.6% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 1.9% of all crashes in the Southern Command.

The Southern Command is driven to provide this community with a professional and effective law enforcement presence. The Southern Command extends a thank you to all those who assisted us in gaining success in our law enforcement services this past month.
