Overview

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Southern Command personnel handled 972 crashes in September 2012. Of these, 679 were property damage, 290 were injury, and 3 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 9.8% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities decreased 40%. 21 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles 11 resulted in injuries, 21 were property damage, and 0 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 3.3% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 2.5% of all crashes in the Southern Command.
