Overview

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Southern Command personnel handled 1,116 crashes in October 2012. Of these, 809 were property damage, 305 were injury, and 2 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 0.9% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities decreased 33.3%. 53 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles; 18 resulted in injuries, 34 were property damage, and 1 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 4.7% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 2.6% of all crashes in the Southern Command.
