# **Overview**

Southern Command personnel handled 1,066 crashes in December 2006. Of these, 873 were property damage, 330 were injury, and 3 were fatal. The total crashes increased by 2.9% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities had 0.0% change. 49 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles; 8 resulted in injuries, 41 were property damage, and 0 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 4% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 3.7% of all crashes in the Southern Command.

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The Southern Command is driven to provide this community with a professional and effective law enforcement presence.
