Overview

Southern Command personnel handled 977 crashes in June 2013. Of these, 686 were property damage, 283 were injury, and 8 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 4.5% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities increased by 100%. 62 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles; 15 of the commercial crashes resulted in injuries, 44 were property damage, and 3 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 6.3% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 2.3 % of all crashes in the Southern Command.

The Southern Command is driven to provide this community with a professional and effective law enforcement presence. The Southern Command extends a thank you to all those who assisted us in gaining success in our law enforcement services this past month.

- ✿ Percentage of commercial vehicle crashes to total crashes 6.3 %
- ✿ Total crashes decreased 4.5% compared to last year.
- ✿ Commercial vehicle crashes increased 67.6 % from last year.
- ✿ Fatality crashes increased 800% compared to last year.
