- ✿ Percentage of Commercial Vehicle crashes to total crashes 5.8 %
- ✿ Total crashes **Up 3.1 %** compared to last year.
- ✿ Commercial vehicle crashes **UP 22.4 %** from last year.
- ✿ Fatality crashes **Up 17.6 %** as compared to last year.
