# **SAFESTAT REPORT**

## **Overview**

For the month of May, the Northern Command West focused its enforcement efforts throughout the region. We had a total of 7,556 public contacts in the field for the region. The region also provided 40 hours of training in support of the cadets at the academy.

Northern Command West handled 301 traffic crashes for the month of May. Of those, 204 were property damage, 95 were injury, and 2 were fatal crashes. Total crashes increased 7.5% from last year. We handled 13 commercial vehicle crashes which is a decrease from last year by 7%. In our overall totals for the month, intoxicated drivers were responsible for 18 crashes in the region which was a decrease from last year.

Northern Command West arrested 86 intoxicated drivers this month, which is a increase from last year. The average blood alcohol level of those intoxicated drivers was 0.21%. Of those arrested for DUI, the average age was 30 years old and 28% had prior DUI convictions. Our officers arrested a total of 149 people for a total of 403 charges during the month of May. In other areas of enforcement, our officers issued 2329 speeding citations, 898 hazardous moving citations, and 331 seatbelt citations.

During the month of May, the Northern Command West conducted directed enforcement assignments targeting the goals of the Strategic Highway Safety Plan and the NHP Strategic Plan. We conducted directed enforcement which focused on violations such as impaired driving, hazardous moving, speed enforcement, distracted driving, and seatbelt awareness. The region continued its effort to educate motorists and bicyclists on the laws related to both and ways to share the roadway. We are continuing to develop an enforcement plan for this program which will be implemented soon.

Northern Command West conducted Traffic Incident Management (TIM) classes at the Regional Public Safety Training Center, which involved allied agencies. The goal is to have all the regional personnel trained on the T.I.M. concept by the end of June.

### TOTAL ENFORCEMENT / SPECIAL OPERATIONS:

- **RUT:** Reno Urban Traffic conducted several productive SHSP overtime assignments focusing on distracted driving; occupant restraint; pedestrian enforcement; impaired driving; speeding; and hazardous moving violations.
- CTM: Carson Tahoe Minden conducted day to day coverage and targeted enforcement with our efforts geared toward the SHSP, and the Highway Patrol Strategic Plan, focusing on Hazardous moving violations, speed, DUI, Seatbelts, and distracted driving. The increased enforcement resulted in 1412 total violations.

• Rurals: The Fallon/Fernley District conducted a Joining Forces enforcement event with Fallon P.D. on May 28<sup>th</sup> focusing on crosswalk enforcement and education. The Tonopah District utilized overtime for impaired driving enforcement along with assisting the Nye County Sheriff's Office with calls for service in the Round Mountain area due to their staffing issues.
