Overview

Southern Command personnel handled 933 crashes in January 2014. Of these, 652 were property damage, 279 were injury, and 2 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 13.8% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities decreased by 50.0%. 51 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles; 8 of the commercial crashes resulted in injuries, 43 were property damage, and 0 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 5.5% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 3.9% of all crashes in the Southern Command.
