# SAFESTAT REPORT

## Overview

Southern Command personnel handled 830 crashes in June 2014. Of these, 565 were property damage, 262 were injury, and 3 were fatal. The total crashes decreased by 15.0% compared to last year. When compared to last year, fatalities decreased by 62.5%. 8 of these crashes involved commercial vehicles; 3 of the commercial crashes resulted in injuries, 4 were property damage, and 1 resulted in fatality. Crashes involving commercial vehicles represented 1.0% of the total crashes handled by the Southern Command. Impaired drivers were responsible for 2.5% of all crashes in the Southern Command.

The Southern Command is driven to provide this community with a professional and effective law enforcement presence. The Southern Command extends a thank you to all those who assisted us in gaining success in our law enforcement services this past month.

- ✿ Total crashes decreased 15.0% compared to last year.
- ✿ Commercial vehicle crashes increased 33.3% from last year.
- ✿ Fatality crashes decreased 50.0% compared to last year.
